- 4. The integration of assistive technology, exemplified by the presence of Alexa, addresses frequently asked questions. The college's website features adjustable fonts to enhance accessibility for Divyangians.
- 5. Screen readers, notably the open-source NVDA software, are employed to facilitate visually impaired students in navigating computer systems, reading and writing files, browsing the web, and operating various software products. These users receive audio feedback while utilizing keyboard commands.
- 6. The institution extends support for popular applications, including web browsers like Mozilla Firefox and Google Chrome, internet chat software, Microsoft Office 2019, and other office programs such as Microsoft Word and Excel.
- 7. Various formatting features for website text, including font name, size, style, and spell-check functionalities, are readily available.
- 8. The support extends to both 32- and 64-bit variants of Windows operating systems.
